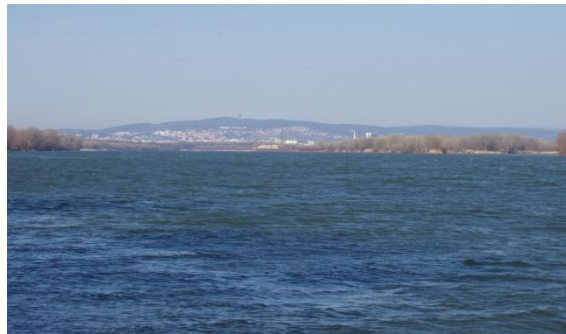

Conference Overview

The International Association for Danube Research was founded in 1956 with the aim of promoting and coordinating activities in the fields of limnology, water management, water protection and sustainable development in the Danube River basin. Since 1998, IAD has become observer and participated actively in the various expert groups of the International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River (ICPDR), contributing to the development of the Danube River Basin Management Plan, the Joint Statement for Navigation, the draft Guidelines for Hydropower in the Danube Region, the Sturgeon Action Plan and the Sturgeon 2020 Program.

The 42th IAD conference will provide a forum for the long-term multidisciplinary research activities and discussions on various topics which reveal the importance of different types of watercourses for the Danube Basin, as well as the interlinkage with the marine area, highlighting the need to protect the biodiversity of this unique area.

Important Information

The official language of the conference will be English. Authors are invited to submit papers related to **the Danube River Basin and the North Western area of the Black Sea**. The scientific presentations will be oral or poster and should relate to one or more of the scientific topics given above. Each presentation should indicate the appropriate topic. All contributions will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to change the form of presentation (oral/poster) in case of thematic consideration or timing. A workshop providing info on funding opportunities for students under IAD umbrella will be organized.

Conference Venue

The conference will take place in the Congress Centre of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (SAS) situated in the well-known Smolenice Castle (www.kcsmolenice.sav.sk). Accommodation and meals have been arranged directly in the Congress Centre; no transfer to other facilities is required.

The Smolenice village is situated at the foothill of the Malé Karpaty Mountains, 60 kms to the northwest of Bratislava.

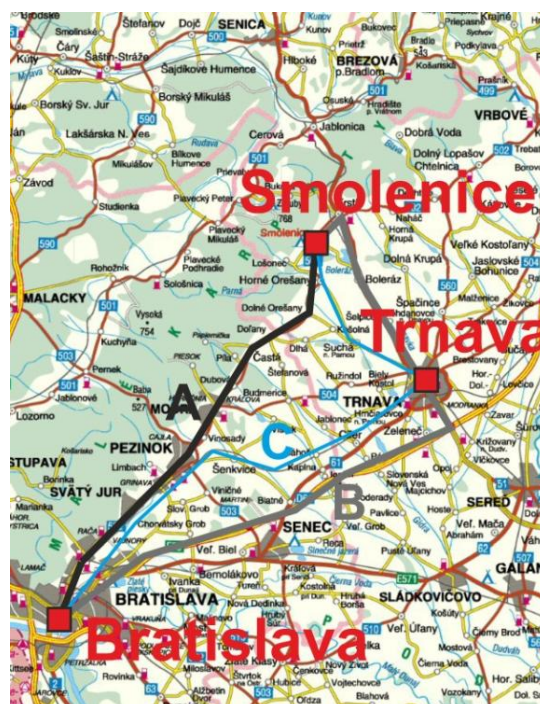
By car:
